

SCOTTISH SCHOOLS - ATHLETIC CHAMPIONSHIPS.

FULL SET OF MEDALS FOR ANNA.

It was a great week-end for the School girls of East Lothian who brought home a total seven medals from the Scottish Schools Athletic Association Championships held at Grangemouth last week-end. North Berwick star Anna Seago, who did so well in the East District Championships, collected a 'full set' of Gold silver and bronze medals, winning the Javelin with a 31.27mt throw, silver in the Long Jump with a leap of 5.44mts and bronze in the Shot with 9.16mts. Sarah Warnock of Musselburgh Grammar took Gold in the Long Jump with 5.68mts and was 4th in the 100mts final in 13.24s.

Megan Gaffney from North Berwick took the Silver medal in the 300mHurdles in 47.73; and Bronze medals were taken by Olivia Mackenzie, Loretto, in the 800mts after she won her heat she clocked 2m29.97 in the final. Rahel Meli Musselburgh Grammar, who has been injured for much of the season will go back to Switzerland after her exchange year with a bronze medal in the 400mHurdles in 68.88s.

Fiona Cleat of Knox Academy ran in both the 100mts reaching the semi final and was 8th in the 200mt final. Rachel Lindsay Dunbar GS won her heat of the 200mts in 27.18s and finished 6th in the final in 27.5s. Katie Hume from North Berwick was 7th in the 400mt final in 64.97s.

The boys did not feature so well, Ross Matheson Preston Lodge won his heat of the 1500mts in 4m22.44 but was 8th in the final and Peter Loudon (PL) was 4th in his 800mt heat in 2m7.63 and 5th in his 1500mt heat in 4m28.22s. Lawrie McLaren DunbarGS had a busy time finished 6th in the Javelin with 42.95mts; 7th in the Shot with 10.66mts and 11th in the Long Jump with 5.43mts.

The East Lothian Athletic Development Group Clubs have implemented a Junior Summer Series of Track and Field events to give novice athletes some competition. The first event was at Pinkie in Musselburgh last week and will be followed on 24th June at Hall Hill Dunbar; 30th June at the Knox Playing field in Haddington and on the 8th July at St. David's Campus Dalkeith. All events start at 6.30pm. The East Lothian Track and Field Championships will be held on Saturday 30th August at St. David's Campus track. Musselburgh Athletic Club will be taking entries.
