

GOOD TURN OUT FOR LASSWADE 10 MILE RACE.

A total of 25 local East Lothian runners turned out last Sunday for the annual Lasswade 10 mile Road Race which despite a last minute route change due to subsidence in Roslin Glen never the less still proved a tough challenge as only 9 athletes beat the one hour mark for the course. Race winner Paul Arcari from Kilbarchan AAC was a very clear winner coming home in 53m05secs. However, Musselburgh based Alistair Hennesy (EAC) stuck to the task on a breezy but bright day that had threatened heavy showers, finished in 6th place in 58m23s. Stuart Hay (Dunbar RC) showed by his excellent run in the National Cross Country Championships that he is form for a good season was 11th in 60m19s and was 2nd V40 to finish. Ian Rowlands (DRC) was 18th in 61m57s and Alan Proudfoot (HELP) was 23rd in 62m21 sec both V40.
