

## TEAM EAST LOTHIAN FINISH THIRD.

Partly due to Scottish Athletics not including Sportshall Athletics as a significant pathway in the development of Athletics for children in Secondary schools, there was a significant reduction in the turn out of teams for this years' Scottish Eastern regional event held on Saturday at Meadowbank. Only four authorities submitted teams, Argyll; Edinburgh; East Lothian and Midlothian.

It was clear from the outset that the Red vested Argyll team had invested strongly in their long bus journey that had started in early morning and were winners of the overall competition by a wide margin. However there were several excellent performances by Team East Lothian:

In the Under 13 Girls events Linzi Moffatt was a comfortable winner in the 4 Lap event in 52.3s backed up by Kerry Morris in 55.5. Both girls had won their respective heats.

Linzi also took 2nd spot in the Standing Triple Jump with 6.23mt and Katie

Cochrane was runner up in the Standing Long Jump with 1.97mt.

In the under 13 Boys section Kieran Sims won the Vertical Jump with 63cms and was 2nd in the 2 lap race final in 23.5sec. Cameron Miller and Robert Ferguson both had runner up slots in the Speed Bounce and High Jump respectively.

In the under 15 boys events Ian Sinclair and Calum Burgess took first and second places in the 2 Lap Race and then went on to help their team win the 4 x 2 Lap relay race.

Ian also took 2nd place in the Standing Long Jump with 7.40mts.

In the Girls Under 15 group Kirsty Wilson was 2nd in the Shot Put with 6.57mts and Rachael Lindsay 2nd in the 2 Lap race in 24.7 secs.
